

PASSING OF OUR COMRADE TINO BRUGOS

With deep sorrow, the Confederación Intersindical announces the passing of our comrade Tino Brugos, which occurred on 10 November 2025.

Tino, born in Santander in 1958 and based in Asturias, was a History teacher and activist of SUATEA and the STEs-Intersindical, and was currently Head of Trade Union Action of the Confederación Intersindical. He dedicated his life to the defence of public education, labour rights, and social justice.

His trade union commitment was always linked to a broad vision of the world and to active internationalist solidarity, participating as an observer in conflicts, denouncing injustices, and defending human rights in places such as Colombia, Kurdistan, Palestine, and Western Sahara.

He was also a pioneer in the defence of LGTBI rights within the trade union and educational spheres, and a key figure in the recovery of democratic historical memory in Asturias and throughout Spain.

Those of us who had the privilege to share struggles and friendship with him will always remember his coherence, humanity, and unwavering commitment to the causes of the people and to a transformative, class-based, internationalist, and solidarity-driven trade unionism.
